Collection

The Site may collect your personal information in different ways:

- When you sign up to our Newsletter and in relation to promotional and marketing materials and activities;
- Through any Contact Us pages if you decide to submit a query, or email eatcuriouslyatseasonedtraveller.com (replacing ‘at’ with the @ symbol);
- When you register for or attend an event organised by or in conjunction with Seasoned Traveller

What information does Seasoned Traveller collect?

The type of personal information that we collect may vary but will generally include your name, email, city and country of residence, year of birth and gender.

Use and disclosure

We will only use your personal information for the purpose for which it was collected, and in some instances for a secondary purpose that is related to the primary purpose, where you would reasonably expect us to do so.

The purposes for which we collect your information may include the following activities (Activities):

- To contact you;
- To send out or provide links to our newsletters, videos, recipes, marketing and promotional material and products and services that you request from us, or which we believe may be of interest to you (unless you have requested not to be contacted for such purposes)

Security

The Site will take reasonable steps to destroy or permanently de-identify personal information we hold if it is no longer needed for our Activities.

Cookies

Cookies are small pieces of data captured by your internet browser when you access online content. When you access the Website we may send a cookie to your computer. Via cookies we may collect anonymous data (including IP addresses) relating to your activity on the Website. We use cookies to measure and understand traffic patterns and to determine which pages on the Website have been visited. We use all of this research to improve the overall user experience on the Website. If you do not wish to receive cookies, you can adjust your browser settings so that your computer does not accept them.
